### Progression

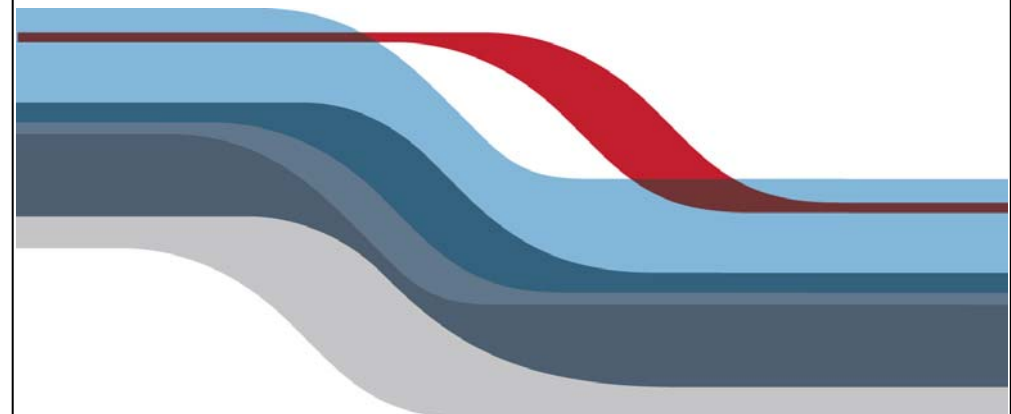

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# Children & Young People's Workforce Apprenticeship QCF Level 2

## Course Outline

Apprenticeships are a proven way to train your workforce. Apprenticeships can make your organisation more effective, productive and competitive by addressing your skills gaps directly, even in uncertain economic times.

This qualification meets the needs of candidates who work or want to work in a wide range of children and young people's settings. It covers the age range 0-16 years for example in the roles of:

- Daycare
- Crèches
- Schools
- Pre-School/Playgroups
- Child minder's own homes
- Children's centers or home childcare
- Hospitals

The level 2 certificate is suitable for candidates working under supervision, such as a Nursery Assistant or Playgroup Assistant working with children under five, or an Assistant Play worker in an out of school setting.



## Delivery and Costs

The majority of the funded training is for 16 to 19 year olds. For those aged 19+ government funding is reduced and Employers are required to make a fee contribution.

South Thames College offer a flexible approach to the delivery of this Apprenticeship which includes e-learning. Each apprentice will be assigned a tutor/assessor who will work with them in all aspects of their Apprenticeship.

## Course Duration

This Apprenticeship has a framework that has been developed specially for the Children & Young People's Workforce. The course will last a minimum of **12 months**.

## Apprenticeship Framework

There are a number of elements to each Apprenticeship. This Apprenticeship framework has 2 main strands:

Competence Based Element	Key or Functional Skills
<b>Level 2 QCF Certificate in Children &amp; Young People's Workforce</b>	<b>English Level 1</b> <b>Maths Level 1</b>

There is no knowledge based requirement as the level 2 certificate is a combined knowledge and competence qualification.

## Course Content

To achieve the Level 2, candidates must achieve 31 credits from the mandatory units and a minimum of 4 credits from the optional units available.

Mandatory Units:

- Introduction to Communication in Children and Young People's settings.
- Introduction to Personal Development in Children and Young people's settings.
- Introduction to Equality and Inclusion in Children and Young People's settings.
- Child and Young Person development.
- Contribute to the Support of Children and Young people's development.
- Safeguarding the Welfare of Children and Young People.
- Contribute to Children and Young People's Health and Safety.
- Support Children and Young People's Positive Behavior.
- Contribute to the Support of Positive Environments for Children and Young People.
- Understand partnership working in services for Children and Young People.
- Maintain and Support relationships with Children and Young People.
- Pediatric Emergency First Aid.
- Managing Pediatric Illness and Injury.
